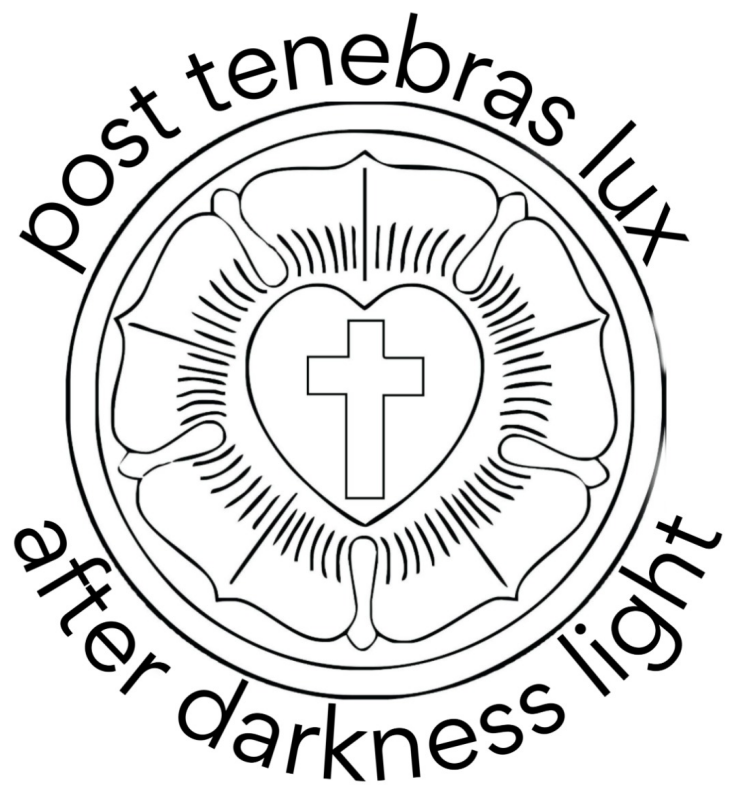
WITTENBERG, 1517

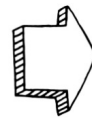
